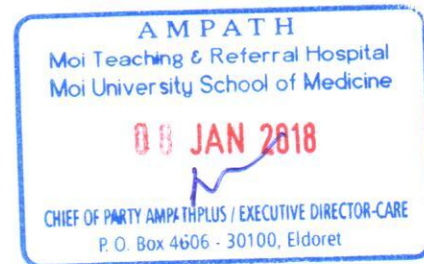
JOB VACANCIES

The Academic Model Providing Access to Health Care (AMPATHPlus) is a program under the auspices of Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital (MTRH) and Moi University whose aim is to provide sustainable efforts in access to health care. AMPATHPlus supports the Ministry of Health in eight (8) Counties of Western Kenya Region, with a catchment population of an estimated 3.5 million people.

The PMTCT Cascade is a 2-year prospective observational study that aims to re-define the PMTCT cascade and the factors associated with loss-to-follow-up in HIV-positive pregnant and postnatal women, and HIV-exposed infants in Busia, Kakamega, Kisumu, Nakuru and Uasin-Gishu Counties.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Planning and co-ordinating activities at the Sub County and community unit levels;
- Linking the study with the County and Sub- County Ministry of Health;
- Coordinating training and supervising the Community Health Volunteers (CHVs) ;
- Enrolment and follow up visits of Study participants (home visits);
- Planning and co-coordinating data collection meetings at Sub County and community unit levels;
- Preparing and submitting reports (monthly and quarterly) on the Study progress;
- Consenting study participants and administering questionnaires to participants;
- Any other duties as may be assigned.

Qualification and Experience:

- Diploma in clinical Medicine/Nursing;
- Be registered with Kenya Clinical Officers Council or Nursing Council of Kenya;
- Have at least 2 years' experience in practicing. Having been HIV/PMTCT clinician/nurse is an added advantage;

- Have knowledge in Microsoft Office;
- Be able to compile weekly and monthly reports;
- Have experience in data collection, data entry and report writing;
- Be a resident of the county you apply for will be an added advantage;
- Have good communication and problematic skills;
