HTS Providers (CHS/HR/SP/HTSP/01/2020)

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Provide quality HTS to clients in adherence to the National algorithm
- 2. Ensure testing of all eligible clients both in the facility and targeted community tests-PNS contacts
- Ensure all identified positives are linked to care and treatment. Physically escort clients for enrolment if within the facility. Phone tracking for inter-facility linkages to ensure linkage and enrolment.
- 4. Offer first adherence counselling sessions to newly identified clients
- 5. Maintain high standards of HTS provision in line with NASCOP-MOH guideline
- 6. Take responsibility of RTK commodities assigned to them and reporting for the same.
- 7. Document all activities as guided in the various HTS related registers and wall charts
- 8. Be part of the facility MDT, Supporting in decision making and client management.
- 9. Refer all eligible men for VMMC
- 10. Participate in monitoring and evaluation activities for the facility.
- 11. Any other duties and may be assigned by the supervisor/team lead

HTS Screeners (CHS/HR/SP/HTS/01/2020)

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Coordinate Infection prevention & control activities in the PSC and other SDPs in the facility
- 2. Screen all the patients accessing care in the health facility
- 3. Provide routine health talks in the facility in liaison with the facility team lead
- 4. Escort all eligible patients to the HTS Service delivery points
- 5. Conduct pretest sessions with the patients to support clients for opt in to testing
- 6. Participate in monitoring and evaluation meetings for the facility
- 7. Participate in client follow up for testing
- 8. Support the facility at the triage areas
- 9. Any other duties as may be allocated by the team lead/supervisor.

Clinicians (CHS/HR/SP/C/01/2020)

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Oversee all care and treatment activities in the assigned health facilities
- 2. Offer mentorship and support to colleagues both clinical and support staff in the facility ,taking lead in sharing of knowledge and updates in the various areas/topics through OJTs,CMEs,Health talks
- 3. To provide on-going support to other HIV Programming areas: HIV prevention, care and treatment activities in assigned site
- 4. To assist in facility monitoring and evaluation with reporting through national HMIS tools and other tools in use by CHS and its funding partners
- 5. Take charge in maintaining quality through QI approaches as well as elements of operations research including identification and documentation of 'best practices' to ensure high quality HIV/AIDS service provision
- Oversee follow-up care of PMTCT clients and HIV exposed infants in the facility, ensure all PMTCT mothers are tested as per guidelines, are on the recommended regimen and their infants are followed up as recommended.
- 7. Support in GBV services: identification, Post GBV care, documentation and referral for relevant services e.g legal.
- 8. Take lead in screening PLHIV for TB and other OIs, giving IPT to all eligible and diagnostic work up for all presumptive TB cases.
- 9. Take lead in support for pharmacy activities: Commodity management, facility reports generation, and pharmacovigilance reports.
- 10. Participate actively in the facility MDT and support decision making for better outcomes
- 11. Any other duties as may be assigned by the team lead/supervisor.

- 1. Diploma in any of the following disciplines: Kenya Registered Community Health Nursing, Kenya Registered Nursing, Kenya Registered Midwifery, Kenya Registered Nursing/Midwifery or Kenya Registered Nursing/Mental Health and Psychiatry from a recognized institution;
- 2. Diploma in Clinical Medicine and Surgery or Clinical Medicine from a recognized institution
- 3. Registration Certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Kenya or a Certificate of Registration from Clinical Officers Council
- 4. Must have a minimum of one year experience in HIV service provision;
- 5. Valid practicing license from Nursing Council of Kenya;
- 6. Certificate in computer application skills from a recognized institution;
- 7. Must be a Kenya Citizen; and
