SECTION A: GENERAL INFORMATION ON 2JIAJIRI

This is a partnership project by KCB Foundation and the Employment and Skills for Development in Africa (E4D) Programme of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH. The overall project objective is to increase employability and income generation for the youth in the construction sector in Kenya. The project will also support the provision of construction toolkits to select youth to enable them to establish their business enterprises in the construction sector. In addition, select youth will benefit from low-cost financing for various products & services to support their journey towards being a successful entrepreneur.

About the ‘Skills and Enterprise Development’ Project

The project offers scholarships for needy youth in short technical courses in building & construction. This will be achieved through practical oriented vocational training, life skills, work readiness training and enterprise development skills necessary to drive employment and wealth creation in the construction sectors.

The scholarship will run between 3 to 6 months and the certification level will be NITA grade 3.

Each training intake is expected to run for 6 months and will consist of 3 months classroom training with practical exercises and 3 months industrial attachment with construction projects. It is expected youth will be funneled into employment once they complete their attachment; while youth interested to establish their own micro-enterprises or scale up existing ones will be supported in business development services.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Eligibility: To qualify for the skills and enterprise development project scholarships all applicants must fulfill the criteria below:

- Applicant should be a Kenyan youth aged between 18-35 years old and have a National ID
- Have at least Kenya Certificate of Primary Education (KCPE) or above
- Commit to attend all training sessions in participating Technical Training institutions in their County of residence
- Must be willing to take up a National Industrial Training Authority (NITA) grade test certification
- Applicants must be within one of the three categories (Business Owner, Apprentice or Skiller) – Refer to Section D

NOTE

Applicants will be given equal opportunity and shall not be discriminated on the basis of disability, gender, regional, religious and ethnic background. **Women and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) are highly encouraged to apply.**
