VACANCY NO. KSI/PSB/EA/3/2022: LIVESTOCK PRODUCTION ASSISTANT JOB GROUP 'G' (5POSTS) TERMS:

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Duties will be –In charge of ward livestock extension, collecting livestock Data at the ward, delivering weather advisories, mobilizing communities, conducting farm visits and demonstrations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Participating in animal health field demonstrations, agricultural shows and exhibitions;
- Participating in sample collection and dispatch;
- Inspecting livestock stock routes; and collecting data and writing technical reports;
- Demonstrating and training on milking techniques and external parasite control techniques such as dipping, spraying and dusting;
- Carry out vaccination, closed castration, dehorning, ear-tagging, branding, de warming, disbudding, docking, de beaking and hoof trimming;
- Carrying out simple treatment of animals;

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Will be in-charge of the sub county livestock production.
- Coordinate in animal health field demonstrations, agricultural shows and exhibitions at the Sub-County Level;
- Coordinate in sample collection and dispatch at the Sub-County level;
- Inspecting livestock stock routes; and collecting data and writing technical reports;
- Coordinate carrying out of vaccination, closed castration, dehorning, ear-tagging, branding, de warming, disbudding, docking, de beaking and hoof trimming at the sub-county level;
- Coordinate carrying out of simple treatment of animals;

- (iv) have a certificate in Computer applications from a recognized institution; and

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Carry out serological surveys under supervision of the Veterinary Officer in charge of the Veterinary Laboratory.
- Carry out supervised sample collection under the Veterinary Officer in charge of the Laboratory.
- Carry out routine Lab tests on samples presented to the Veterinary Laboratory for various diagnostics.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Carry out meat inspection and/or artificial insemination services.

- Perform veterinary field extension services that include farm visits, barazas and field days;
- Assist in disease control programs such as disease surveillance, vaccinations and reporting.
- Demonstration and training in animal husbandry techniques
- Undertake closed castration, dehorning, de-worming, disbudding, docking, de-beaking and hoof trimming.
- Prepare reports from their area of jurisdiction

- (vi) Be compliant to Chapter six of the constitution
- (vii) Meat inspection and / or artificial insemination training will be an added advantage

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Demonstrating to traders and skin flayers on the appropriate methods

- of flaying, cleaning, curing and storage of hides and skins;
- Ensuring that hides and skins are delivered to the curing premises immediately after flaying, collecting hides and skin data on production;
- Grading, identifying defects and issuing dispatch notes to facilitate hides and skins movement as a disease control measure; and
