CYPRUS INSTITUTE OF NEUROLOGY AND GENETICS (CING) POST-GRADUATE (MSc) SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/2025

The Cyprus Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and Genetics (CING) are informing of up to three (3) postgraduate (MSc) scholarships for the academic year 2024-2025.

Each scholarship covers:

- Full tuition fees (€8,000) for citizens who will apply and be accepted to the CING based on academic criteria. The candidates will be evaluated on their academic qualifications, provided they fulfil the CING entry requirements.
- 2. Stipend to cover accommodation and living expenses in Cyprus. A minimum stipend of €1375 will be offered to every successful student. The stipend can be increased up to €8000/student depending on the availability of funds. All students will be informed upon acceptance to the CING

CING applies international standards of excellence in its curriculum. It serves as a Centre of Excellence and a Referral Centre for Basic and Applied Research in Biomedical and Clinical Sciences. Our dynamic range of programmes includes the innovative disciplines of Neuroscience, Molecular Medicine, Medical Genetics, Biomedical Research and Biotechnology,

disciplines sought after and very popular for students in Biomedicine. Students enrolled at CING benefit from the dynamic setting and have a unique

- 2. MSc in Medical Genetics

All programmes are accredited by the Republic of Cyprus, the European Union countries and other third countries.

Minimum Entry Requirements

To be admitted to the MSc Programs, a student must meet at least the minimum requirements listed below:

- 1. A Bachelor's degree from a recognised accredited institution, in a related field
- 2. English Language Certification or other accepted International Standard, if the previous degree obtained was not in English

Application Procedure

The CING Admissions period begins in late January every year, for programs beginning in September of that year.

Required Documents

1. A Completed Online Application Form

- 2. Two Academic References
- 3. Academic Transcripts
- 4. English Language Certificate (if not graduated from an English speaking University)

Note:

Health Insurance coverage is recommended for all students.
