- 5. Craft concept notes and proposals to secure funding for social outreach and ministry initiatives.
- 6. Ensure accountability and adherence to best practices and donor conditions, ensuring compliance.
- 7. Build and maintain relationships with donors, funding agencies, and other stakeholders to cultivate support for social outreach and ministry initiatives.
