#### **QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE**

### A. TEACHING POSITIONS

#### PROFESSOR - GRADE 15

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in the relevant area of specialty. In addition, applicants must:

- i. Have at least twelve (12) years of university teaching experience, three (3) of which as full time Associate Professor;
- ii. Have at least sixty (60) publication points, forty (40) of which are from articles in refereed scholarly journals since being appointed Associate Professor;
- iii. Have successfully supervised to completion at least six (6) Masters and two (2) PhD students since being appointed Associate Professor;
- iv. Show evidence of successfully securing at least two (2) research grants since being appointed Associate Professor;
- v. Show evidence of attendance and contribution of learned conferences, seminars or workshops;
- vi. Show evidence of active participation/leadership in university activities; and
- vii. Show evidence of continued research.

# ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR – GRADE 14

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in the relevant area of specialty. In addition, applicants must:

- i. Have at least eight (8) years of university teaching experience, three (3) of which as full time Senior Lecturer;
- ii. Have at least 48 publication points, 32 of which are from articles in refereed scholarly journals since being appointed Senior Lecturer;
- iii. Have successfully supervised to completion at least five (5) Masters and one (1) PhD student since being appointed Senior Lecturer;
- iv. Show evidence of successfully securing at least two (2) research grants since being appointed Senior Lecturer;
- v. Show evidence of attendance and contribution at learned conferences, seminars or workshops;
- vi. Show evidence of active participation/leadership in university activities; and
- vii. Show evidence of continued research.

### **SENIOR LECTURER - GRADE 13**

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in the relevant area of specialty. In addition, applicants must:

- i. Have at least five (5) years of university teaching experience, three (3) of which as full time Lecturer;
- ii. Have at least 32 publication points, 24 of which are from articles in refereed scholarly journals since being appointed Lecturer;
- iii. Have successfully supervised to completion at least four (4) Masters students since being appointed Lecturer;
- iv. Show evidence of successfully securing at least one (1) research grant since being appointed Lecturer;
- v. Show evidence of attendance and contribution at learned conferences, seminars or workshops;
- vi. Show evidence of active participation/leadership in university activities; and



#### **LECTURER – GRADE 12**

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree from a recognized university in the relevant area of specialty. In addition, applicants must:

- i. Have a Master's degree in addition to a first degree from a recognized university in the relevant field:
- ii. Show evidence of attendance and contribution at learned conferences, seminars or workshops; and
- iii. Show evidence of continued research. Those who have university teaching experience and have published in refereed journals will have an added advantage.

#### **TUTORIAL FELLOW - GRADE 11**

Applicants must be holders of a Bachelor's degree of at least Second Class Upper Division and a Master's degree from a recognized university in the area of specialty. In addition, applicants must be registered for a PhD degree and have made substantial progress in their PhD studies. Evidence of progress made in the PhD studies (e.g. PhD progress report) MUST be submitted with the application.

# B. **NON-TEACHING POSITIONS**

## DRIVER II- GRADE 3/4 - Ref: (UoEm/TD/01/2025)

Applicants must be holders of at least KCSE D+ (plus) /KCE DIV IV and be in possession of a valid driver's license class A B C E, or for smart driving license B, C1, C, D1, D2, D3 and Occupational Trade Test III for drivers. In addition, they must;

- i. Have at least five (5) years accident-free continuous driving experience;
- ii. Have a valid certificate of good conduct from the Kenya Police;
- iii. Demonstrate proficiency in written and spoken English and Kiswahili languages; and
- iv. Demonstrate ability to drive buses and lorries.

## TECHNICIAN IV (FARM MACHINERY) - GRADE 5/6 Ref: (UoEm/FMT/01/2025)

Applicants must be holders of at least KCSE C- (Minus) /DIV III, and a Diploma in Agricultural Engineering, Agricultural Mechanics or Mechanical Engineering from a recognized institution, and be in possession of a valid driver's license class G. In addition, they must;

- i. Have at least three (3) years relevant post qualification work experience with at least one year of service as a technician in a higher education institution;
- ii. Experience in operating, repairing and maintaining farm machinery; and
- iii. A certificate in computer proficiency.

## TECHNICIAN II (MEDIA LABORATORY) - GRADE 5/6 - Ref: (UoEm/MLT/01/2025)

Applicants must be holders of at least KCSE C- (Minus) / DIV III, and a Diploma in Mass Media, Journalism or Media/Broadcast Technology from a recognized institution. In addition, they must;

- i. Have at least three (3) year's relevant post qualification work experience in a media lab, or broadcast studio preferably in an institution of higher learning;
- ii. Have experience in operating and maintaining media production equipment such as cameras, microphones, audio mixers, lighting equipment, and video and audio editing software;



- iii. Have proficiency in using and troubleshooting various media production equipment; and
- iv. Have a basic understanding of IT systems and networking as related to media production.

A relevant Higher Diploma will be an added advantage.
