The Unlocking data initiative is a collaborative initiative of Zizi Afrique Foundation (ZAF), University of Malawi, Effective Basic Services (eBASE), Education Sub Saharan Arica (ESSA) and Edtech Hub which is being implemented in three countries: Kenya, Malawi and Cameroon. - Assist in implementation of research studies and evaluations.

- Extensive knowledge of both qualitative and quantitative statistical analysis.
- Proficiency in literature review and evidence synthesis.

- Experience in the usage of computers and office software packages (MS Word, Excel, etc.)
- Knowledge and experience in coordinating group learning, ability to capture, analyse and synthesize information.
