Purpose: To glorify God by offering specialized paediatric and intensive health care by carrying out investigations and procedures necessary to establish a diagnosis, make recommendations, and provide holistic treatment and management to sick children.

<u>**Job Duties and Responsibilities**</u>

- Work alongside relevant staff to meet operational and medical care requirements of paediatric and PICU patients
- Ensure the proper input of treatments, payments and paediatric inpatient data into HMIS and help maintain the paediatric department database of outcomes
- Participate in outpatient clinic work as needed to maintain continuity of care for complex patients from inpatient to outpatient
- Coordinate the provision of paediatric care services for admitted patients, including providing consults to other consultants covering other wards
- Conduct reviews of inpatient files for purposes of quality assurance on various aspects including quality of care and documentation
- Coordinate continuous quality improvement programs to improve intensive paediatric care
- Participate in inpatient call with the paediatric team call rotation, shared equally amongst the consultants
- Be available for mass casualty situations and other paediatric needs from the Casualty department
- Provide training and teaching opportunities to staff within the Paediatric Department
- Provide teaching and training to interns and other learners within the hospital, including residents, students, and interns (both bedside and formal)

Applicants Qualifications, Experience, Competencies and Attributes

- Bachelors Degree in Medicine and Masters in Pediatrics and Child Health, or equivalent
- Fellowship training in Pediatric Intensive Care or Pediatric Emergency Medicine
- A minimum of five (5) years' medical work experience

- Possess a valid private practicing License
- Ability to effectively influence support from and add value to a wide range of professionals
