- f) Providing input for the development of Business cases/Project justifications Monitoring compliance of projects being executed within the Authority with Project Management Guidelines.
- g) Support in implementing board resolutions.
- h) Support in Implementing the Authority's Quality Management System within the Section.
- i) Facilitating audit and other compliance-related activities within the Section.
- j) Drafting and implementing the Section's Workplans, Budgets, and Procurement Plans in line with the corporate strategy and performance contract obligations.
