- Prepare accurate medical reports required for patient referrals, transitions of care, and insurance purposes.
- Provide strategic leadership and guidance for the establishment of radiation oncology services at the hospital.
- Participate in clinical audits, morbidity & mortality (M&M) reviews, and quality improvement projects.
- Provide oncology consultative support for non-oncology specialties.
- Support patient education, counseling, and navigation services.
